Assumptions:	These figures assume that a child will attend preschool at four years of age and attend school at five years.
Source:	The Australian Scholarships Group conducted an online education costs snapshot survey among its Member parents during August 2009. Education cost information was captured about more than 2400 children from ASG Members who participated in the survey. The survey asked parents to estimate the costs associated with tuition fees and levies, requisites, clothing, incidentals, and computer and internet costs that they paid for their children in the education stages of preschool, primary and secondary schooling at government, systemic (eg Catholic), and private centres and schools. *Note: Preschool figures were collected in 2006 and have been indexed as outlined below.
Education Costs Data:	National education costs data has been used to complete this table. State-based information is available and can be accessed from the ASG website using ASG's Education Costs Calculators - www.asg.com.au
Summary Amounts:	Summary amounts include Tuition Fees and Levies, Requisites, Clothing, Incidentals, Computer and Internet Costs.
Tuition Fees and Levies:	Includes total tuition and/or annual, fees, charges, levies, and fundraising contributions.
Requisites:	Includes items such as stationery, textbooks, school bag, art and craft materials, sports and music equipment, and other requisites appropriate to the stage of schooling for each child.
Clothing:	Includes school-related special clothing requirements, basic school uniform - summer and winter, blazer, shoes, sports uniform/tracksuit appropriate to the stage of schooling for each child.
Incidentals:	Includes items such as outings, camps, private tuition, music lessons, instruments, coaching, gym/drama/art/dance classes, travel and commuting to school, or any other costs appropriate to the stage of schooling for each child.
Computer and Internet Costs:	Includes computer hardware and software (eg purchase or rental of desktop computer and/or laptop computer, software applications and programs, computer levies, etc) and internet access costs at home and/or at school.
Indexation:	Figures have been indexed by the relevant Consumer Price Index (CPI) averaged over the past nine years to September 2009. *Preschool and primary tuition fees and levies have been indexed by the CPI Preschool and Primary Education Sub-Index growth factor averaged over the past nine years up to September 2009 of 5.9%. #Secondary tuition fees and levies have been indexed by the CPI Secondary Education Sub-Index growth factor averaged over the past nine years up to September 2009 of 6.85%. Actual CPI amounts to September of each year have been applied to each year. Indexation of all other figures has been applied according to the CPI All Groups Index growth factor averaged over the past nine years up to September 2009 of 2.85%.
