



## Government Teachers Awarded Top Marks

NEiTA (National Excellence in Teaching Awards) and the Australian Scholarships Group have announced the names of the 60 Australian teachers to receive NEiTA 2009 ASG Inspirational Teaching State and Territory Awards. Of these 60 teachers, 80 per cent teach within government early childhood centres or schools, 12 per cent within independent, and eight per cent teach within Catholic education environments.

NEiTA's Chairman, Mr Terry O'Connell congratulated all the award recipients who were nominated for the awards by the real consumers of education – parents, schools and early childhood communities.

"These teachers have made a vital contribution to their communities through their teaching. They often give much of their personal time to help ensure their students receive every opportunity to experience the gift of learning and knowledge in stimulating and welcoming environments," Mr O'Connell said.

"Of particular note in this year's awards, is the high level of teachers from government education settings who have received recognition through the awards. Increasingly, governments are acknowledging the importance of a quality education to Australia's children and the nation as a whole. Inspirational teachers play a key role in a child's learning and are receiving their rightful recognition.

"The NEiTA teaching awards program offers communities a way of showing their heart-felt thanks and appreciation for those special teachers who make a profound impact on their students, parents, wider communities, and their profession," Mr O'Connell explained.

Of the 60 NEiTA ASG Inspirational Teaching State and Territory Award recipients, 10 teach in early childhood, 30 in primary, and 20 in secondary school education. This year, 33 per cent of the award recipients are school principals or early education centre directors, while 67 per cent are teachers. In addition, the recipients' teaching experience spans between two and 47 years.

The breakdown by state, includes:

- ❑ Australian Capital Territory – two teachers (one - early childhood; one – primary; and both from government education environments)
- ❑ New South Wales – 14 teachers (one – early childhood; eight – primary; five – secondary; and 10 – government; two – Catholic; two – independent)
- ❑ Northern Territory – two teachers (one – early childhood; one – primary; and both from government education environments)
- ❑ Queensland – 13 teachers (two – early childhood; eight – primary; three – secondary; and 11 – government; one – Catholic; one – independent)
- ❑ South Australia – six teachers (one – early childhood; two – primary; three – secondary; and five from government and one from independent education environments)
- ❑ Tasmania – three teachers (one – early childhood; one – primary; one – secondary; and all from government education environments)
- ❑ Victoria – 12 teachers (two – early childhood; six – primary; four – secondary; and 10 – government; two – independent education environments)
- ❑ Western Australia – eight teachers (one – early childhood; three – primary; four – secondary; and 10 – government; two – Catholic; two – independent education environments)

The awards showcase the diversity of Australia's teaching profession. Examples of the inspirational teachers' work includes: taking their students and subjects into the wider community, participating in special education and community events, assisting those with special needs, contributing to their students' understanding of their communities and the environment, re-engaging students, presenting real life learning experiences in the classroom, and connecting students to technological learning experiences.

"Teachers are among a child's most important role models, second only to a child's parents, so recognising and rewarding our most effective teachers is crucial," Mr O'Connell said.

The NEiTA teaching awards program was established in 1994. It has helped pioneer teacher recognition and appreciation. This year, NEiTA received more than 1200 nominations for teachers across Australia.

The NEiTA 2009 ASG Inspirational Teaching State and Territory Award recipients will now be eligible to progress through to the next phase of the awards at the national level. Selected from the NEiTA ASG Inspirational Teaching State and Territory Awards recipients, 10 teachers will receive National Awards commemorated with a specially crafted NEiTA crystal apple award and a professional or project development grant of \$5,000. National Awards will be granted across three categories: Leadership and Development, Innovation, and Community Engagement. One National awardee will be selected as Australia's Inspirational Teacher to participate in the International Space Camp held in Alabama, USA, in July 2010.

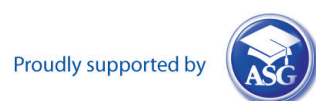
