ASG today announced assistance for members who have been impacted by Cyclone Debbie.

ASG chief executive officer John Velegrinis said ASG is concerned with the impacts that such events have on individuals, families and communities and wishes to assist its members in times of hardship.

"As a member owned organisation we understand that such events have an adverse impact on people's lives. We know that our members' first priority is to focus on their families' physical safety, but we want them to know that when they are ready and able to contact us, we will be here to help," he added.
