John also works across the school on a variety of projects to ensure positive attitudes towards education and improvements in social engagement. Specifically, he has driven social engagement projects with specifically targeted students experiencing social difficulties, in the form of a twice-weekly games club. The games club provides a stimulating alternative to busy playground play, and an avenue for successfully promoting cooperation, turn taking and conflict resolution.
