During his 24 years in rural, regional and remote schools in New South Wales, David Lloyd has earned a reputation as a progressive and innovative principal, whose focus on the implementation of practical, high-level, relevant teaching programs ensures the highest standard of teaching and learning for students.

Valued for his consultative approach to teaching, David builds genuine partnerships with teachers, parents and the community, and seeks their advice to build a positive school culture. David is also regarded as highly approachable by his students and he works to understand individual student circumstances to ensure each student achieves their goals, often despite adversity.

David also believes in creating a culture in which teachers are nurtured to use data to reflect their individual teaching style. This is achieved via a high level teaching and learning leader position, whose role is to demonstrate, mentor and coach individual classroom practice.

In the past three years, under David's leadership, Orange High School has increased its enrolments by 15 per cent, and its attendance by 2.5 per cent, evidence of the benefits a team approach can bring to a school environment.
