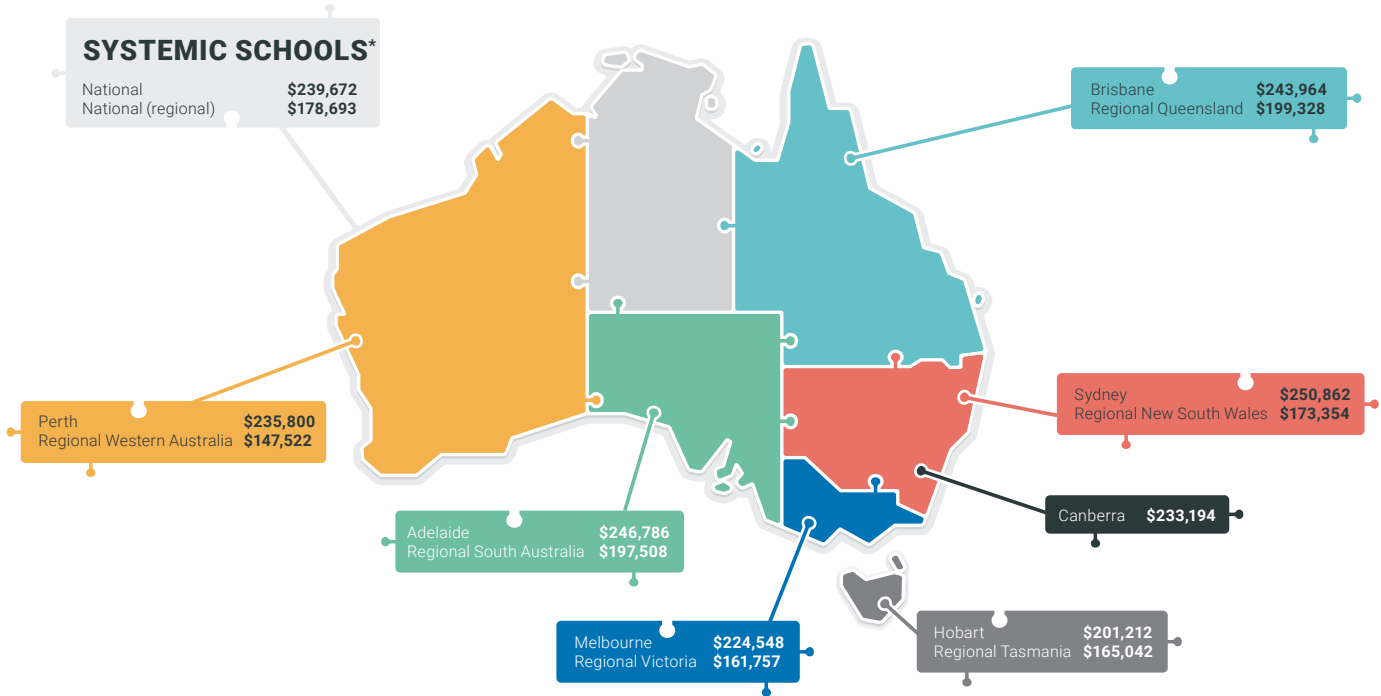


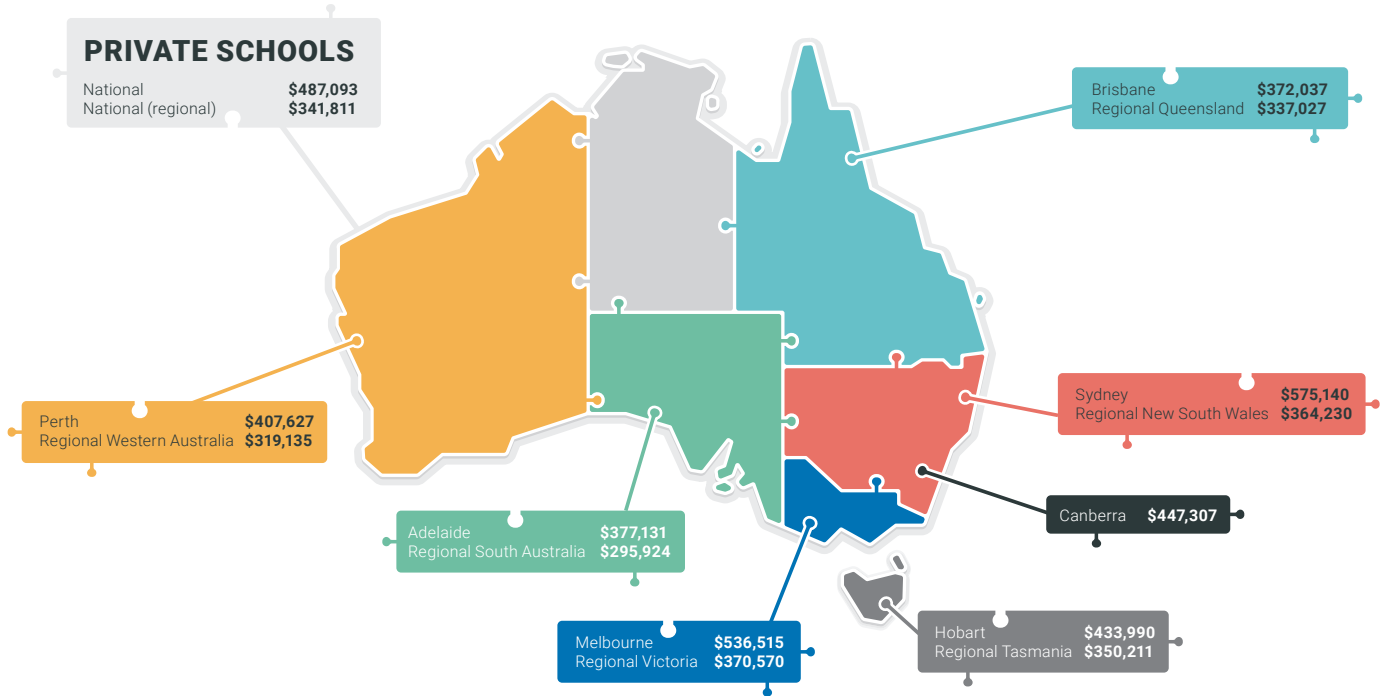

Estimated average costs to educate a child in regional and metropolitan Australia for a child born in 2017.



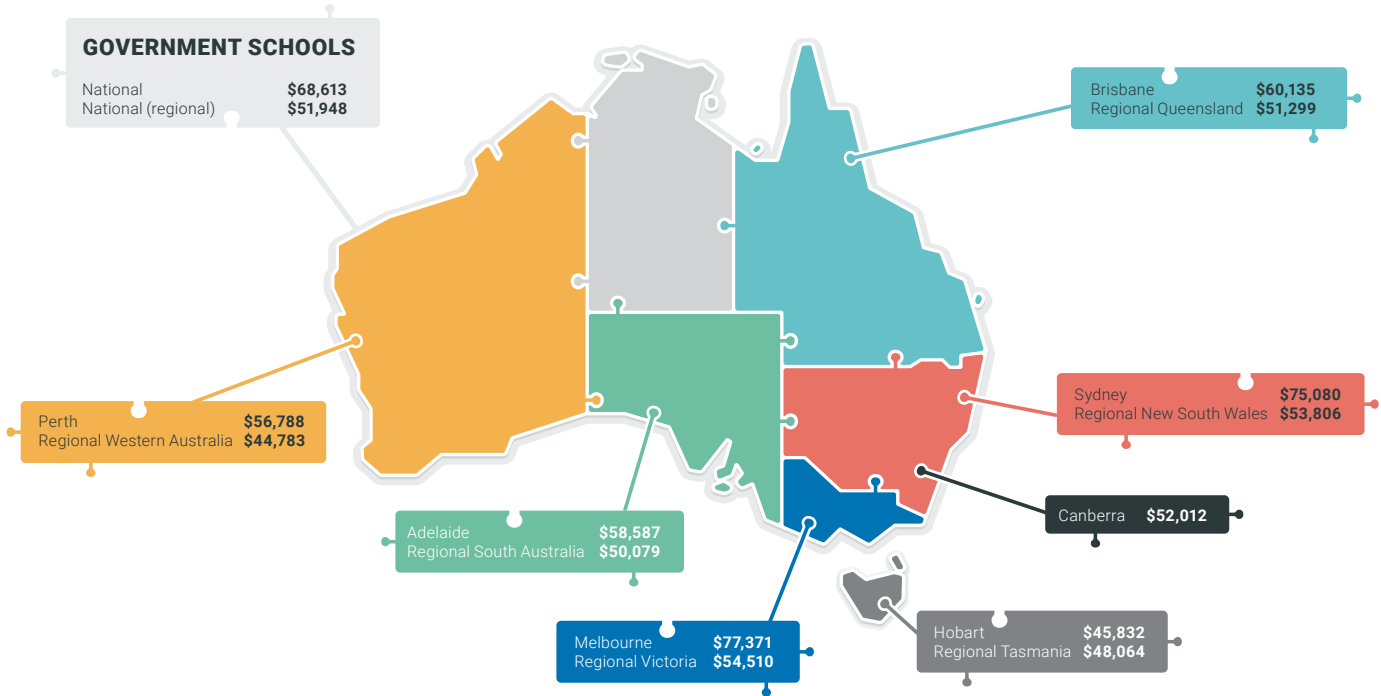

Estimated average costs to educate a child in regional and metropolitan Australia for a child born in 2017.



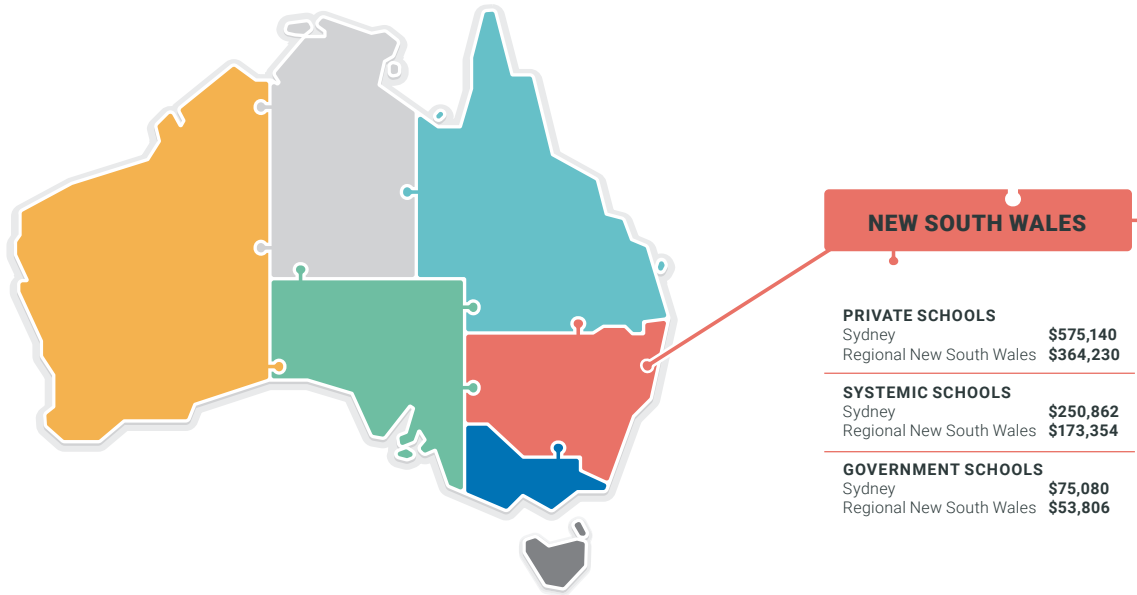

Estimated average costs to educate a child in regional and metropolitan Australia for a child born in 2017.



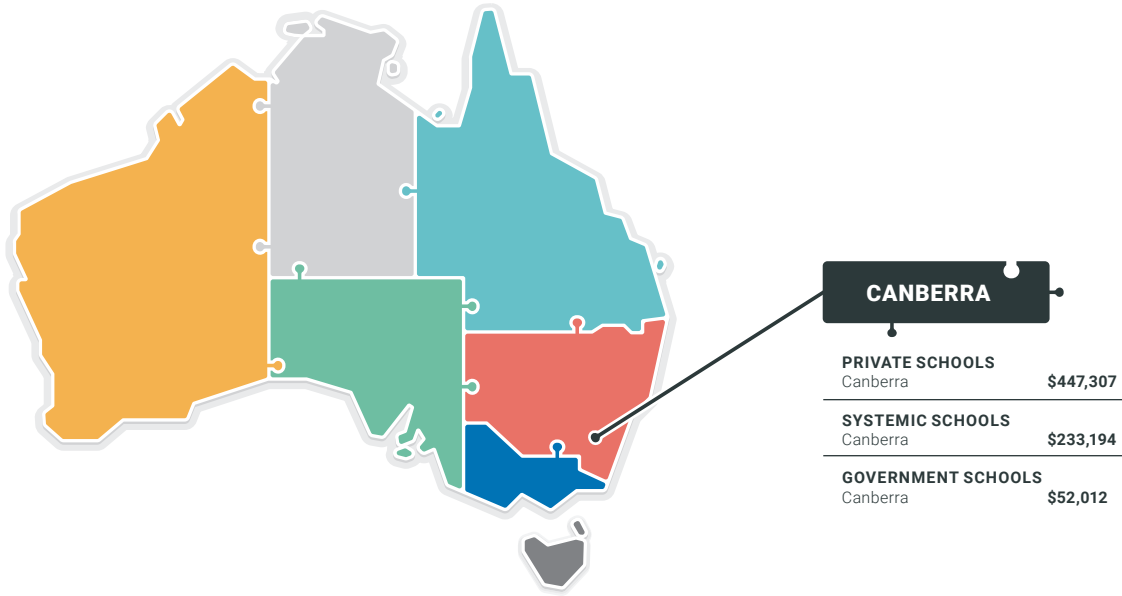

Estimated average costs to educate a child in regional and metropolitan New South Wales for a child born in 2017.



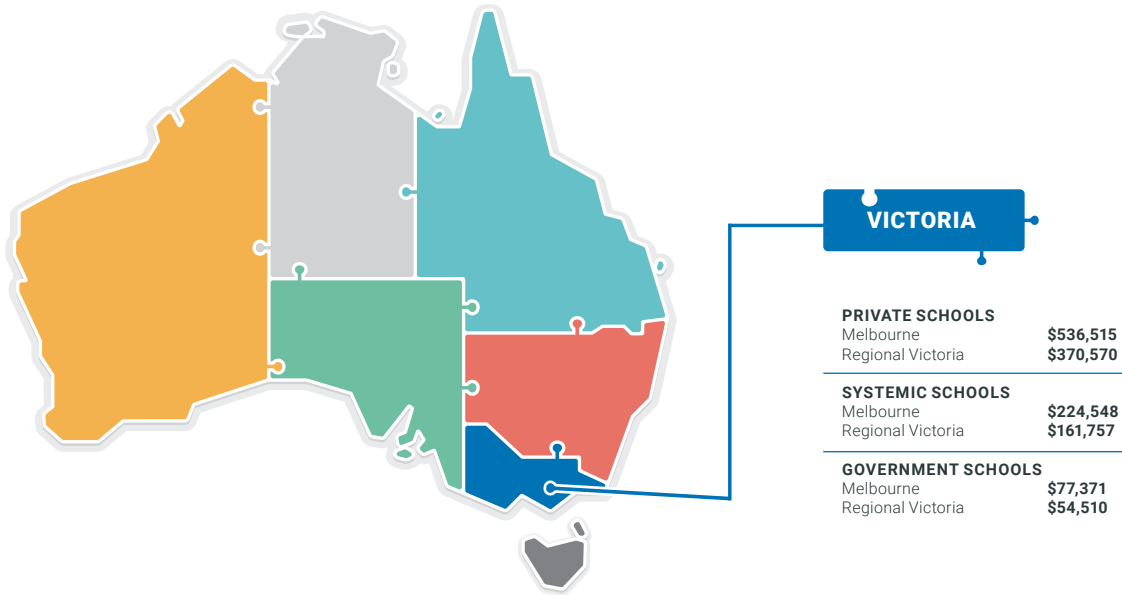

Estimated average costs to educate a child in metropolitan ACT for a child born in 2017.



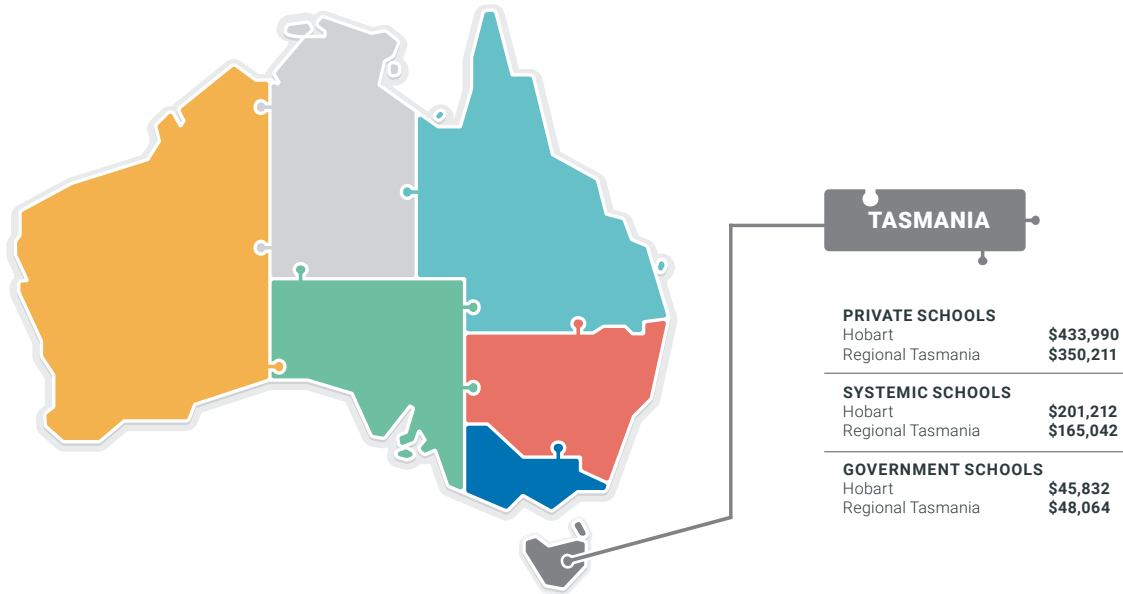

Estimated average costs to educate a child in regional and metropolitan Victoria for a child born in 2017.



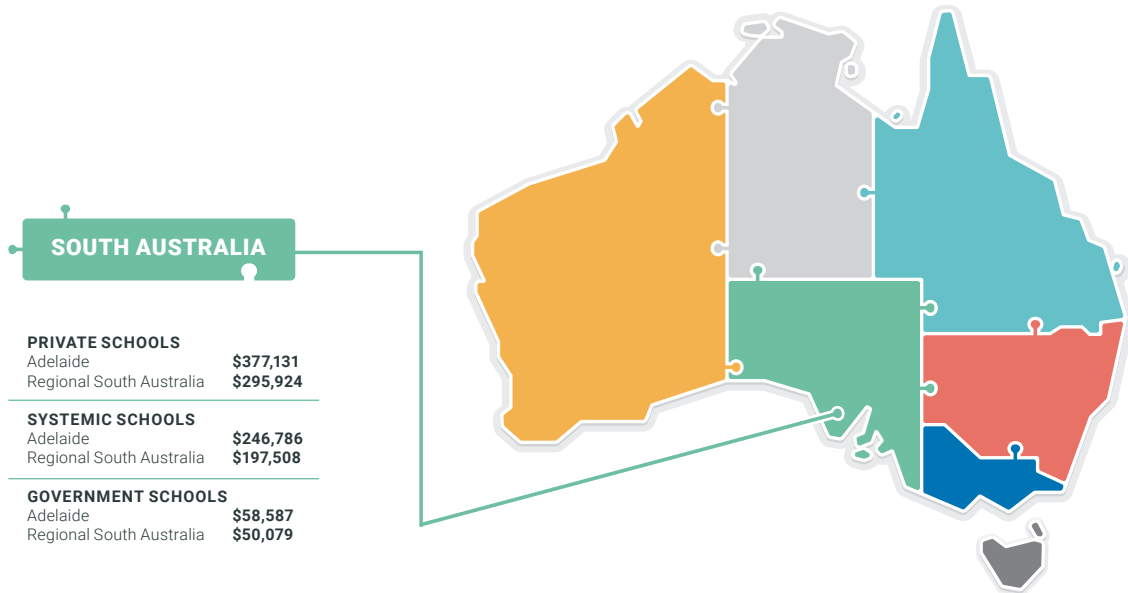

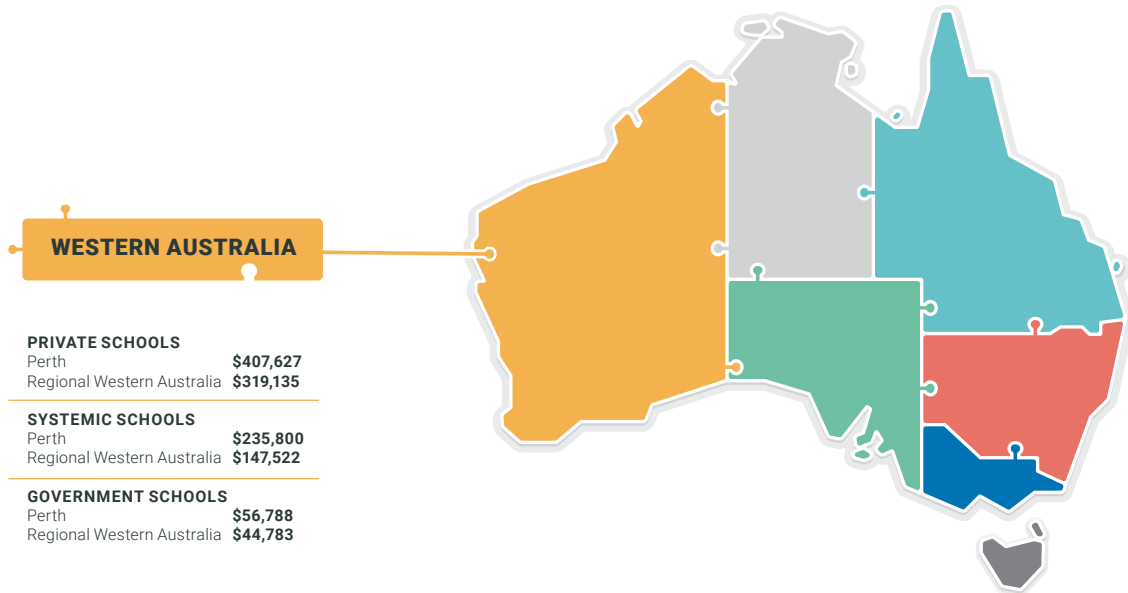
Estimated average costs to educate a child in regional and metropolitan South Australia for a child born in 2017.

Estimated average costs to educate a child in regional and metropolitan Queensland for a child born in 2017.




